

HYDRANT FLUSHING NOTICE

The City of Marshall Water Department will be conducting its annual Spring hydrant flush starting April 20, 2020. This process could take up to four (4) weeks to complete. Flushing will begin at 8:00 am and end at 3:00 pm Monday through Friday. Flushing will begin at the Water Plant on E. Green St. Customers should be aware of change in water pressure and color of their water as these are common characteristics of hydrant flushing. **Motorists are encouraged to slow down and use caution when approaching crews flushing hydrants.** We will update the City of Marshall Facebook page daily with our progress.

In normal years, most residents would be at work or at school. This year with more residents at home during our flushing program, there is more of a chance the changes to the water system could be noticed. We will make our best efforts to clear the water as soon as it can be. Please understand that we have limited employees working and that phone calls about rusty water or low water pressure may not be answered right away. These changes to your water are temporary and could last a few minutes or most of the day.
