



Dear Water Customer,

On Tuesday, July 19, 2022, the City of Marshall will be shutting down water on Mansion from N. Kalamazoo to Division. During installation of new valves last Friday, one of the existing valves at Eagle and Mansion failed and needs to be replaced. This shut down is expected to last most of the day as we replace old broken valves.

After work is complete, the water will be turned back on and flushed to remove any air or sediment in the lines. After water has been restored it will be necessary to issue a boil water advisory. This advisory will have instructions on how to use water while it is in effect. Samples will be taken from the water main and sent to our lab to make sure that the water is safe to drink. Once samples are in the lab it will take 48 hours to determine if the samples are negative for harmful bacteria. A notice will be sent to every residence affected when samples have been approved and the water is safe to drink.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this work has caused.
